The American Language and Culture Program (ALCP), a subdivision in the International Services Office at the University of Detroit Mercy is looking for an innovative and dynamic adjunct faculty member to teach English as a Second Language to newly-arrived UDM non-immigrant international students who lack sufficient English proficiency. Duties consist of assignments in the Fall 2018 semester (August 27-December 14, 2018) at the main McNichols campus. The tentative available class would be on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday mornings, starting August 29th. We have some flexibility with the class time.

Other duties include: providing copies of syllabi and course materials to their supervisor upon request; assigning and submitting grades; using computer and multimedia technology; participating in curriculum development and revision.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Applicants should have a Master's degree or be a candidate for a Masters degree in teaching English as a second language or in teaching English to speakers of other languages or in a closely related field. Strong cross-cultural communication skills and ability to communicate with speakers with limited English skills are necessary. ESL teaching experience is preferred. Overseas teaching experience and experience learning another language are desirable.
